1. To clean the exterior of the unit, use a damp, soft cloth. 2. Wipe dry with a dry, soft cloth. 3. Wash non-electrical accessories in warm, soapy water and allow to dry thoroughly. 4. The microfibre cloths can be washed on a 30 degree wash. Do not use fabric softener, do not iron, do not tumble dry and do not bleach. How to...

...descale your steam mop 1. Use a measuring cup to make up a mixture of approximately 100ml of distilled water and 50ml of vinegar. It is best to complete this descaling in the handheld mode. 2. Carefully pour the water-vinegar solution into the water tank and replace the water tank filling cap. 3. Plug in the power and set the steam control dial to MAX. Allow the unit to heat up and produce steam.

The accessories for the handheld steamer allow for different types of cleaning. The table below is a guide to uses for the accessories.
