Our total carbon footprint

When combined with our existing Scope 1 and 2 data, we are now able to establish a value chain baseline for our carbon emissions and have committed to setting a Scope 1, 2, 3 and FLAG¹ science-based target. We'll set this ahead of our previous 2025 deadline.

While undertaking this work, we continue to engage suppliers, dedicating our 2021 supplier sustainability conference to asking 150 of our strategic supplier partners to make climate commitments for the products they sell us before the end of 2022.

Our full carbon footprint baseline is 30,372,830 HOZe (-2% on 2020)
