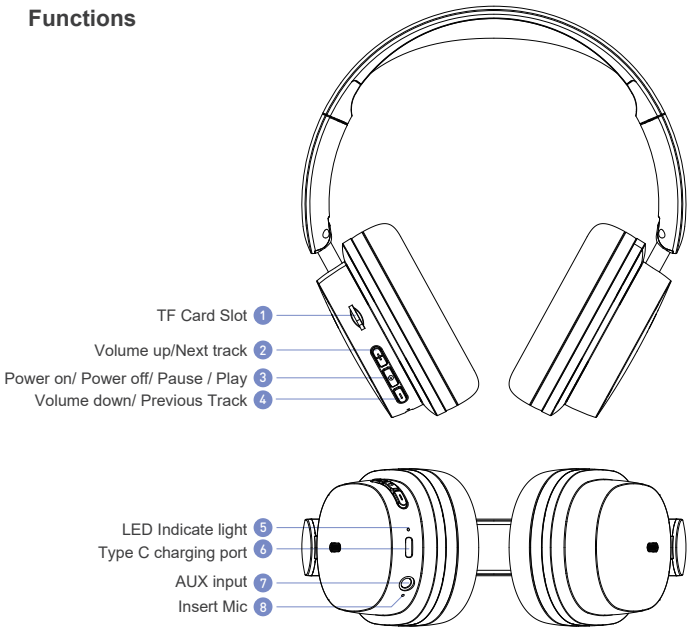

Bluetooth operation	
Bluetooth Pairing Name	AT-T2
Power On	Hold the power key ③ for more than 3 seconds. "Power on " will be heard and LED will flash Red and Blue.
Power Off	Hold the power key ③ for more then 5 seconds " Power off " will be heard and the LED will extinguish
Pairing	When powered on the headphones will automatically connect to your device if previously paired. If not paired you will hear a voice prompt "Bluetooth pairing" search for AT-T2 on your device and after successful pairing you will hear voice prompt "Bluetooth connected"
Bluetooth disconnected	When Bluetooth has disconnected you will be notified with a voice prompt "Bluetooth Disconnected"
Playing music	
Play/pause	Press once Key ③ to play or pause music
Next track	Long press Next Track Key ②
Previous track	Long Press Previous Track Key ④
Volume +	Short press Volume + key ② to increase volume level. When the maximum level is reached your will hear a chime
Volume -	Short Press Volume - Key ④ to decrease volume level

Incoming call	Whist receiving an incoming call you will hear a ringing tone and the LED will flash Blue
Pickup the phone	Press the Play key ③ to answer call
Hang up the phone	Press the Play Key ③ to terminate call
Reject call	Long Press the Play key ③ to reject call
Last number redial	Press the Play key ③ twice in quick succession
Built-in battery-saving feature	Your headphones will automatically switch off after 5 minutes if there is no active connection between your device
Battery low	When the battery is low, a voice prompt will be heard "Battery Low"
Charging	Insert the USB-C charging cable into the headphones, once charging starts the LED will illuminate Red
Changing completed	When charging is completed the LED will extinguish and the USB -C connector should be removed

Trouble shooting

The headset cannot be turned on
Ensure headset is fully charged before turning it on. Confirm that you charger and lead is working.

Cannot find headphones in Bluetooth list
Check that the headphones are in pairing mode (blue/red indicator lights flashing).
Check that they are disconnect from any paired devices.

The Headphones keep disconnecting and/or burbling sounds
The operating range is approximately 10 meters in ideal conditions. If you move beyond this, the connection may drop.
• Check that the device is fully charged
• Check for Interference from other devices, example metal objects can obstruct signal
• Phone case interfering with signal propagation
• Low signal quality

When answering a call, I can not hear anything
Ensure the mobile device is connected to headphones and its not on speaker phone mode
Increase the volume.
