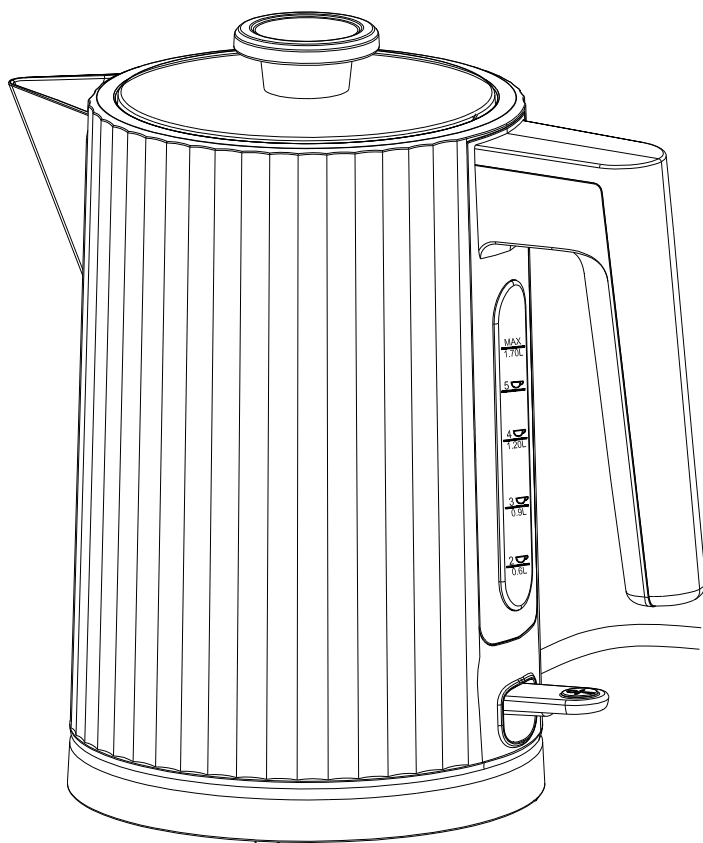

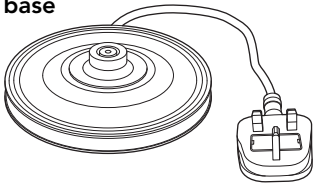
CAUTION. RISK OF SCALDING. DO NOT OPEN LID WHILST KETTLE IS HOT. BE CAREFUL WHEN POURING BOILING WATER FROM YOUR KETTLE AS THIS CAN RESULT IN INJURY. ENSURE THE SWITCH IS NOT OBSTRUCTED OR THE KETTLE WILL NOT SWITCH OFF.

1. Read all warnings & instructions in this manual to ensure you get the best out of your product.
2. For household use only. Not for use outdoors.
3. This appliance is only suitable for domestic use and is not designed for commercial purposes.
4. This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and if they understand the hazards involved. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children unless they are older than 8 and supervised. Keep the appliance and its cord out of reach of children aged less than 8 years.
5. This appliance can be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.
6. Children shall not play with the appliance.
7. ASDA does not recommend allowing children to operate this appliance.
8. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
9. Before connecting the kettle to the power, check the voltage shown on the appliance base corresponds with the voltage in your home. If it doesn't, contact your dealer and don't use the kettle.
10. If the kettle is overfilled, boiling water may be ejected.

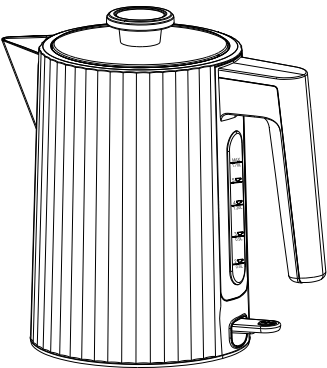
11. Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot water.
12. Always disconnect the kettle when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool.
13. Only use the kettle with the base provided. Do not use the base for any other purpose.
14. When pouring, don't tip the kettle too fast. Always use the handle and don't touch the body (as this can get very hot).
15. This appliance is not intended to heat liquid other than water.
16. The cord shouldn't hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch a hot surface.
17. Keep away from hot gas and electrical burners.
18. Remove all packaging prior to use. Inspect the product for any damage before use. If damage is found, notify ASDA to exchange the product.
19. Keep away from harsh or abrasive cleaning agents or solvents.
20. Do not use attachments not recommended by the manufacturer.
21. Don't use the kettle for anything other than its intended use.
22. Please don't dismantle. If a fault occurs have the kettle inspected in a qualified repair shop or return to us at ASDA.
23. To avoid fire, electric shock, or injury, never immerse the kettle, cord or plug in water or liquid. Do not use with wet hands.
24. Always make sure the lid is closed while the kettle is boiling and avoid contact with the steam coming from the spout.
25. Always place on a firm, level surface, out of reach of children.
26. Be careful when refilling an already hot kettle.
27. Avoid boiling without water as this can damage the heating elements.
28. **WARNING!** Avoid spillage on the connector.
29. Regarding the instructions for cleaning surfaces, please refer to the chapter "Cleaning your kettle".
30. **WARNING!** Misuse may lead to injury.
31. **WARNING!** The heating element surface is subject to residual heat after use.
32. Environmental information: If at anytime in the future you should need to dispose of this product, please note that, in the UK, waste electrical products/batteries should not be disposed of with household waste.
33. The power consumption was 0 W in the off mode.

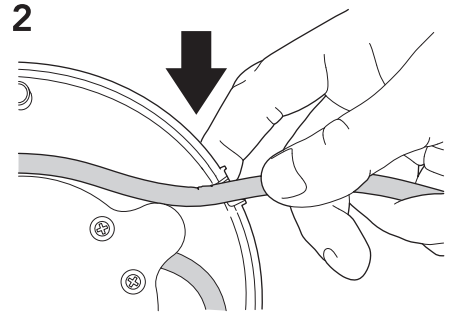


Power base

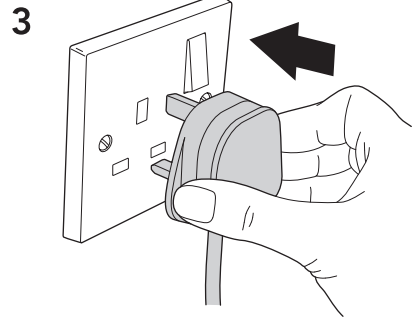
1. Unwind the power cable to your required length.



2. Fit the power cable firmly into the base slot so it is stable.



3. Slot the plug into an electrical socket and then turn the power on if required.



Please note

If you're using the kettle for the first time, we recommend cleaning before use by boiling and discarding a full kettle of water twice. Then simply wipe the surface down with a damp cloth.

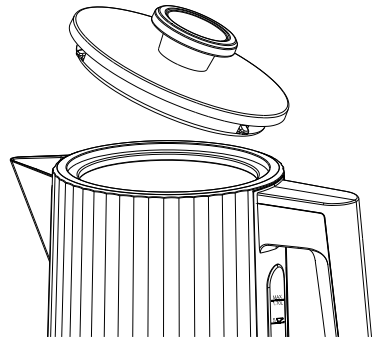
If you accidentally boil the kettle when it's empty, the kettle will switch off automatically. If this happens, allow the kettle to cool before filling it with cold water and re-boiling.

You can shut off the power whilst the kettle is boiling by pushing the on/off switch up.

Using your kettle

1. Lift the lid off the top of the kettle, then fill the kettle with water to your desired level.
Take care not to exceed the MAX fill level on the water gauge.
If you're refilling a kettle after it has boiled, be cautious of steam emitted from the kettle.

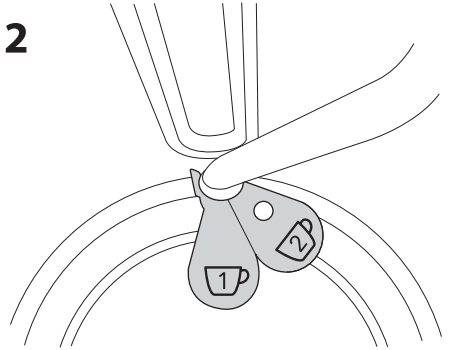

2. The inside of your kettle is equipped with a '1 CUP' and '2 CUP' indicator. If you only wish to boil enough water for one or two cups, please fill your kettle with water to just above the desired level marker.

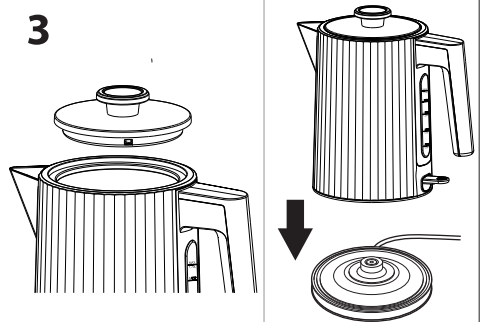
Filling the kettle below the one cup mark can overheat the elements and cause damage.

3. Slot the lid back on securely. Place the kettle onto the base, making sure it's seated properly.

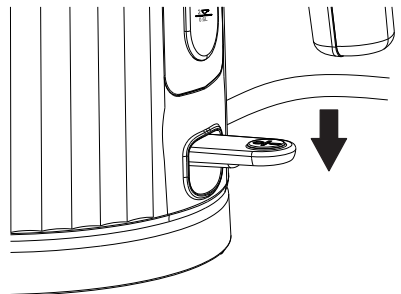


4. Push the On / Off switch on the back of the kettle down to boil.

This will light up to let you know boiling has begun.

The kettle will automatically switch off once the water has boiled, so you don't need to worry.

Descaling your kettle

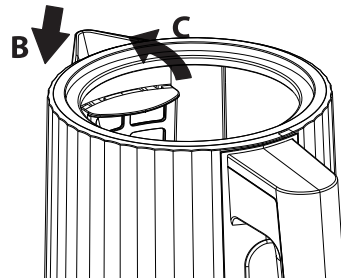
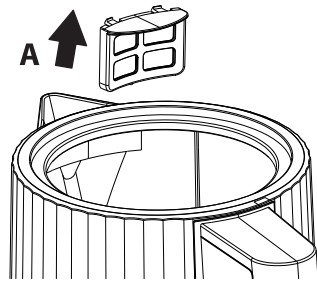
Your kettle should be de-scaled regularly, depending on how often you use it and how hard your water is. Excessive scale can cause the kettle to switch off before boiling and may damage the elements, affecting your warranty.

To de-scale, simply purchase an all-purpose de-scaling product suitable for your kettle and follow the instructions on the pack. Ensure the electric connections are completely dry before using the kettle.

Cleaning the filter

Make sure the device is disconnected from the power outlet, and the kettle is empty and completely cool.

- 1. Note:** The lid has been removed from the diagrams for clarity. To clean the filter, remove it by simply pulling the lip of the filter upwards and out of its housing (**A**).
- 2.** Wash the filter in warm, soapy water and rinse thoroughly.
- 3.** Refit the filter by aligning the bottom lug on the filter with the bottom of the spout (**B**). Then push the top of the filter back into its housing until it clicks into place (**C**).



Cleaning your kettle

Make sure the device is disconnected from the power outlet, and the kettle is empty and completely cool.

To clean the kettle body, simply wipe with a damp cloth (do not use abrasive cleaners).
