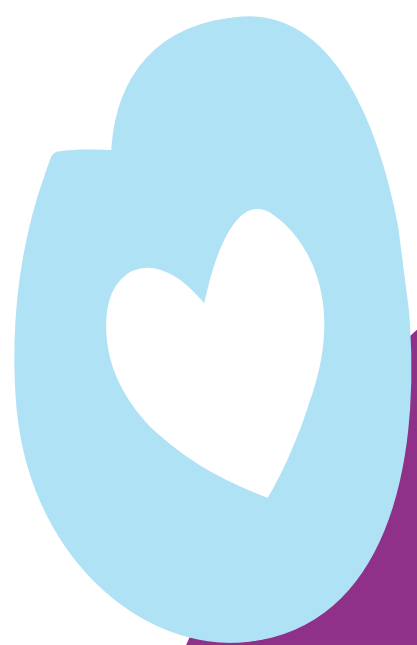

ABOUT RAVEN HOUSE TRUST

Raven House Trust supports people across Newport through its foodbank, furniture provision, community garden and practical skills programmes. The organisation works with individuals and families facing poverty, homelessness, food insecurity and social isolation, providing both immediate support and opportunities to build confidence and independence.

Around 2,000 people access the organisation's services each week, with partnerships spanning schools, community groups, charities and local agencies.

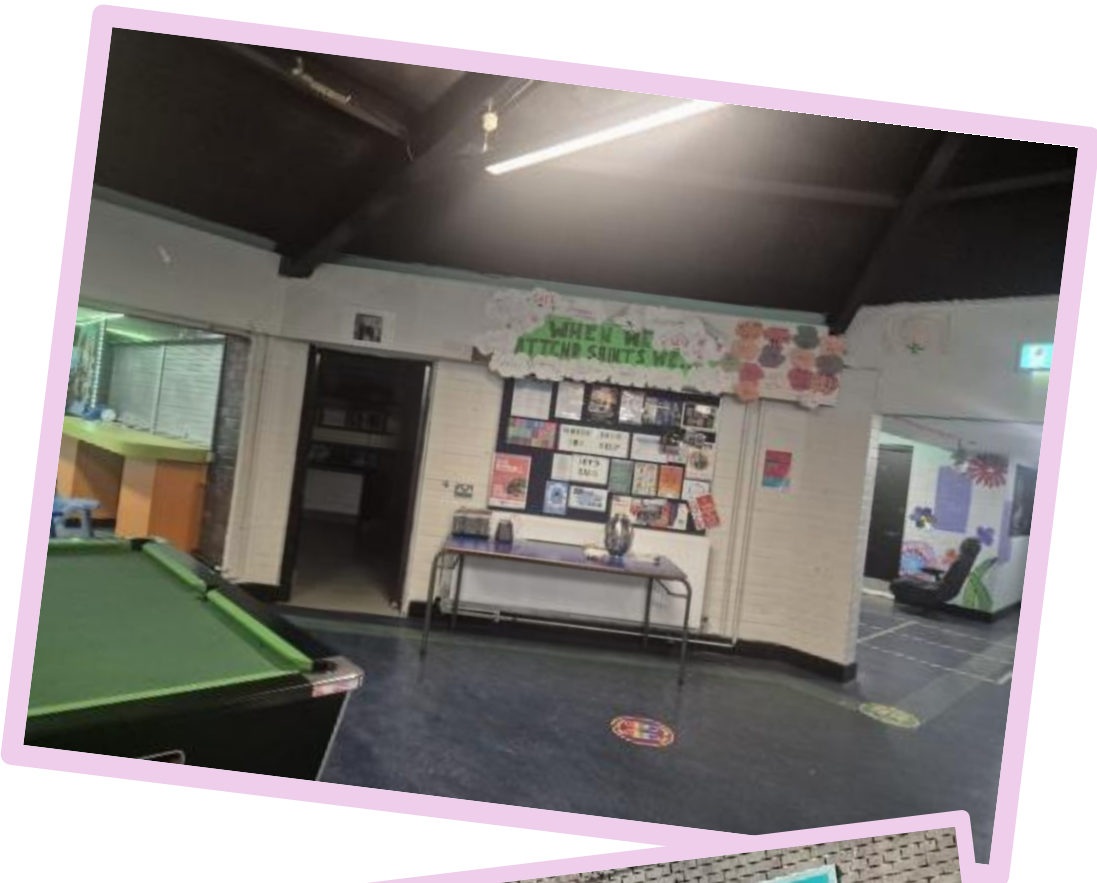
Funding will help create a fully accessible space where local people can learn, grow food, develop new skills and build stronger community connections, supporting healthier and more independent lives.
